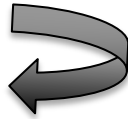

46. **Witch's Broom Limbo:** Play limbo using a broomstick held by two players, with others taking turns bending backward to pass under without touching the broom.
47. **Spooky Scavenger Dash:** Set up a scavenger hunt with clues leading to spooky items hidden around the house, with players racing to find them all.
48. **Ghoul Guess Who:** Play a Halloween-themed version of Guess Who, where players ask yes or no questions to figure out which spooky character their opponent has chosen.
49. **Pumpkin Patch Toss:** Toss small pumpkins or bean bags into a target area marked with a pumpkin patch design, aiming for the highest score.
50. **Monster Mash Musical Chairs:** Play musical chairs with a Halloween twist, with players dancing to spooky music and scrambling for chairs when the music stops, with one chair removed each round.
51. **Spooky Mason Jar Lanterns:** Transform mason jars into eerie lanterns by painting them with ghostly faces and adding LED candles inside.
52. **Creepy Spider Web Wreath:** Create a spooky wreath using black yarn or ribbon wrapped around a wire frame and adorned with plastic spiders.

53. **Haunted House Terrariums:** Make miniature haunted house terrariums using small glass containers, spooky figurines, and faux moss or plants.
54. **Ghostly Floating Candles:** Craft floating candles by attaching LED tea lights to white tissue paper cutouts shaped like ghostly figures.

73. **Spooky Silhouette Votives:** Make spooky silhouette votives by cutting spooky shapes out of black paper and wrapping them around glass votive holders.

75. **Ghostly Footprint Doormat:** Create a ghostly footprint doormat by painting white footprints on a black doormat and adding spooky details.

76. **Spooky Spiderweb Pizza:** Prepare pizza topped with black olive slices arranged in a spiderweb pattern over tomato sauce and cheese.
77. **Creepy Eyeball Pasta:** Cook pasta and top it with mozzarella balls and black olive slices to resemble eerie eyeballs floating in sauce.
78. **Haunted House Sandwiches:** Assemble sandwiches using cookie cutters to create shapes like bats, ghosts, or tombstones from bread slices.
79. **Ghoulish Graveyard Dip Platter:** Arrange a dip in the center of a platter and surround it with breadsticks or crackers, decorating with edible tombstone-shaped cutouts.
