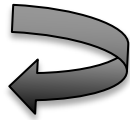




100 Ways to Celebrate Halloween

36. **Pumpkin Tic-Tac-Toe:** Use mini pumpkins and gourds as game pieces on a large tic-tac-toe board drawn on the ground or a chalkboard.
37. **Zombie Tag:** Play a game of tag where one player is designated as the zombie and tries to tag other players to turn them into zombies too.
38. **Halloween Pictionary:** Draw Halloween-themed words or phrases on a whiteboard or paper and have teammates guess what they are within a time limit.

44. **Witch's Hat Walk:** Set up a circle of witch's hats on the ground and play music while players walk around them. When the music stops, players must find a hat to stand under.
45. **Halloween Jigsaw Puzzle Race:** Divide a Halloween-themed jigsaw puzzle into smaller sections and have teams race to complete their section first.
46. **Vampire Bite Freeze Dance:** Play music and have players dance, but when the music stops, they must freeze in place. Anyone caught moving after the music stops is "bitten" and out of the game.
47. **Candy Corn Relay:** Divide players into teams and have them race to transfer candy corn from one container to another using spoons without dropping any.
48. **Pin the Wart on the Witch:** Similar to Pin the Tail on the Donkey, blindfolded players must try to place a paper wart on a drawn witch's face while being spun around.
49. **Halloween Scavenger Hunt:** Create a list of Halloween-themed items for players to find around the house or neighborhood within a time limit.
50. **Bobbing for Apples:** Fill a large tub with water and apples and challenge players to try to grab an apple using only their mouths, with their hands behind their backs.
51. **Spooky Mason Jar Lanterns:** Transform mason jars into eerie lanterns by painting them with spooky designs and adding LED candles inside.
52. **Creepy Crawly Spider Wreath:** Create a spider-themed wreath using black yarn, plastic spiders, and a foam wreath form for a spooky door decoration.
53. **Ghostly Hand Candle Holders:** Make ghostly candle holders by dipping plastic gloves in plaster and shaping them into ghost hands to hold tea light candles.
54. **Haunted House Luminary Bags:** Decorate paper bags with haunted house designs and place LED tea lights inside to create glowing luminaries for your walkway.
55. **Pumpkin Tic-Tac-Toe Board:** Paint rocks to resemble pumpkins and use them as game pieces on a wooden tic-tac-toe board painted with a Halloween theme.

56. **Witch Hat Luminaries:** Turn black paper plates into witch hat luminaries by cutting out the center and adding tissue paper and LED tea lights inside.
57. **Spooky Spider Web Hoops:** Use embroidery hoops and white yarn to create spider webs, then add plastic spiders for a creepy wall decoration.
58. **Jack-o'-Lantern Balloon Garland:** Inflate orange balloons and draw jack-o'-lantern faces on them with black markers, then string them together to create a festive garland.
59. **Ghostly Treat Bags:** Make ghostly treat bags by stuffing white fabric with candy and tying them closed with black ribbon, then adding ghost faces with black markers.
60. **Candy Corn Banner:** Cut triangles from yellow, orange, and white paper and string them together to create a candy corn-themed banner for your Halloween party.
61. **Bat Wing Headband:** Cut bat wing shapes out of black felt and attach them to a headband for a simple and spooky accessory.
62. **Hanging Paper Plate Bats:** Cut bat shapes out of black paper plates and hang them from the ceiling with fishing line for a fun and easy Halloween decoration.
63. **Witch's Potion Bottles:** Fill glass bottles with colored water and add spooky labels to create a collection of witch's potion bottles for your Halloween party.
64. **Creepy Eyeball Wreath:** Glue plastic eyeballs onto a foam wreath form and add a bow for a ghoulishly good Halloween decoration.
65. **Skeleton Hand Candlesticks:** Spray paint plastic skeleton hands black and attach them to wooden candlesticks for a creepy candle holder.
66. **Mummy Mason Jar Candle Holders:** Wrap mason jars in gauze and add googly eyes to create mummy candle holders for your Halloween table.
67. **Spiderweb Doormat:** Use white paint to create a spiderweb design on a black doormat for a spooky entrance to your home.
68. **Pumpkin Seed Art:** Use pumpkin seeds to create spooky art by gluing them onto black paper in the shape of jack-o'-lanterns or other Halloween designs.
69. **Glowing Ghost Lanterns:** Cover jars with white fabric and add ghost faces with black markers, then place LED tea lights inside for glowing ghost lanterns.
70. **Candy Corn Mason Jars:** Paint mason jars with yellow, orange, and white paint to resemble candy corn and use them as vases or candle holders.
71. **Haunted House Treat Boxes:** Decorate cardboard boxes with haunted house designs and fill them with candy for spooky treat boxes for Halloween party guests.
72. **Spiderweb Table Runner:** Use white yarn to create a spiderweb design on a black table runner for a creepy table decoration.

74. **Glowing Ghost Bottles:** Paint glass bottles with white paint and add ghost faces with black markers, then place LED lights inside for glowing ghost decorations.

97. **Ghostly Pudding Cups:** Layer vanilla pudding and crushed Oreos in cups, then top with whipped cream and candy eyes.
98. **Monster Mash Popcorn:** Mix popcorn with candy corn, pretzels, and M&M's for a sweet and salty snack.
99. **Creepy Crawly Ice Cream:** Top scoops of vanilla ice cream with gummy worms and chocolate sauce.
